**Sponsors:** On behalf of CODE BLUE, the Fort Worth Police Department and the Tournament Committee, we invite you to participate at one of the following sponsorship levels:

- \$1000 to \$1999: Two golfer registrations and a course sign with company name, displayed the day of the tournament

**What is CODE BLUE?** Since 1991, The Fort Worth CODE BLUE Citizens On Patrol volunteers have been patrolling neighborhoods and reporting suspicious activity, resulting in a 63% decrease in Part I Crimes since 1995! There are over 800 active registered volunteers patrolling more than 200 neighborhoods acting as our extra eyes and ears.

**About Us:** For the last three decades, Charity Golf Outings (a 501(c)(3) public charity) has supported Code Blue by organizing this charity golf tournament to raise money. Each year the proceeds from this tournament are used to show gratitude to our Code Blue – Citizens On Patrol volunteers by providing funds for training, equipment, and a year-end appreciation and recognition luncheon. Last year over \$15,000 was donated to the Code Blue Program!
